



Christ the King: A Crown of Thorns

The irony of Christ the King Sunday reaches its painful summit at Calvary. Between two criminals, mocked by soldiers and rulers alike, hangs our King. "He saved others; let him save himself if he is the Messiah of God, the Chosen One!" they jeer. One criminal joins the mockery, but the other sees what the crowds miss: "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom." This is the kingdom Paul proclaims in Colossians - not built on military might or political power, but on the blood of the cross. The penitent thief becomes the first citizen of this upside-down kingdom. He brings nothing - no righteousness, no good works, no time left to prove himself. Just honest recognition of his sin and a desperate plea for mercy. This is the scandal and glory of Christ's kingship: his kingdom welcomes the broken, the guilty, the dying. His power is made perfect in weakness. His victory looks like defeat. He doesn't call us to be strong but to endure with patience, as Paul writes, giving thanks to the Father who has rescued us from darkness. On this final Sunday of the church year, we bow before a King whose authority rests not in crushing his enemies but in forgiving them, who rules not from a palace but from a cross.

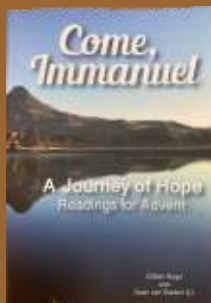

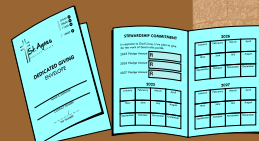
