



Living water for thirsty souls

The woman at Jacob's well came to draw water in the heat of the day, perhaps to avoid the judgment of others. Yet in her isolation, she encountered the One who offers living water that quenches the deepest thirst. Her story reminds us that no one is beyond the reach of God's transforming grace. This Lenten season calls us to honest self-examination. Like the Samaritan woman, we often seek to satisfy our spiritual thirst at broken cisterns—relationships, achievements, possessions—that can never truly fulfill. Jesus meets us in our brokenness, not with condemnation, but with the offer of abundant life. He knows our past, yet sees our potential. Paul writes that we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. This peace isn't the absence of struggle, but the confident assurance that we stand in grace. Even our sufferings produce perseverance, character, and hope—a hope that does not disappoint because God's love has been poured into our hearts. May we become like the Samaritan woman—transformed by encounter with Jesus, running to share the good news that the Messiah has come. In him, our deepest thirsts are satisfied, and we discover the worship that springs from spirit and truth.
