



When God shows up uninvited

There is something quietly radical about the way God breaks into ordinary life - not with fanfare, but through dust, distress, and daily work. Abraham is sitting at the entrance of his tent in the heat of the day when three strangers appear. He doesn't wait for a sign. He runs. He bows. He lavishes hospitality on guests he does not yet fully recognize. And in that very act of generous welcome, the impossible is announced: Sarah, long past the season of childbearing, will have a son. She laughs - the laugh of someone who has learned to protect herself from hope. But God's word stands anyway. "Is anything too wonderful for the Lord?" The question hangs in the air like the afternoon heat, waiting for an answer we are still learning to give. Then Jesus walks through towns and villages, seeing crowds that no one else seems to truly see - harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. His response is not pity that keeps its distance. It is compassion that costs something. He sends his disciples out with nothing but authority and instruction: heal the sick, raise the dead, give freely what you have freely received. God sees what others overlook, enters where others hesitate, and invites us to do the same. The harvest is plentiful. Are willing to be sent?
