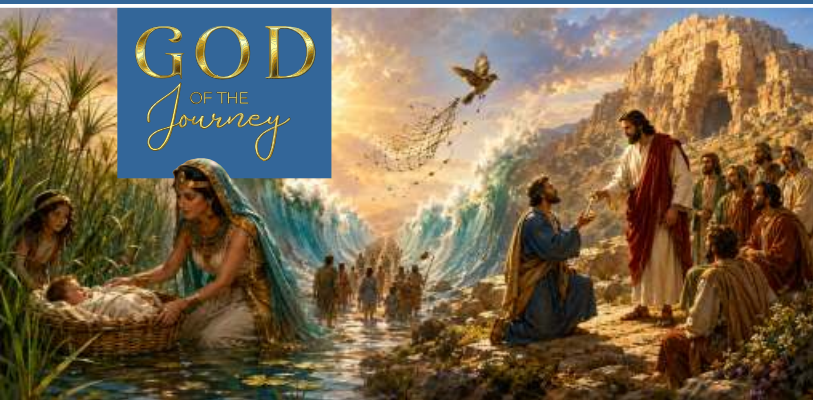




GOD

Journey

Our help was, and is, "in the name of the Lord."

Every journey has an unseen thread running through it. In Exodus, a new king rises who "did not know Joseph," and dread hardens into slavery, into a decree to kill baby boys. Yet defiant midwives, a mother's desperate basket, and a sister's quick courage become the quiet hinges on which history turns. God's name isn't shouted in this passage - no plague, no fire, no voice from heaven. He simply works, through frightened people making brave choices, until a baby drawn from the river becomes a deliverer drawn from bondage. Centuries later, at Caesarea Philippi, Jesus asks His disciples the question every generation must answer for itself: "Who do you say that I am?" Peter's confession - "You are the Christ" - becomes the rock on which everything is built. The journey that began with a hidden baby in a basket leads, ultimately, to the identity of the One who saves. Three passages, one thread: God does not merely observe our journeys - He walks within them, in the ordinary courage of a midwife, in the desperate hope of a mother, in the confession of a disciple. The road may pass through fear, through slavery, through uncertainty. But we are never asked to travel it unaccompanied. He is, and has always been, the God of the journey.

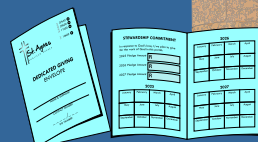
