



I AM: A Name that never leaves

Every journey with God begins in an unlikely place. For Moses, it was a wilderness pasture and a bush that burned without being consumed. For Israel, it was slavery in Egypt, where Psalm 105 reminds us God had not forgotten them - He "remembered his holy promise" and led His people out with joy. For the disciples, it was a hard road toward Jerusalem, where Jesus told them plainly that following Him would mean a cross before a crown. At the burning bush, God doesn't answer Moses' doubts with credentials or strategy. He answers with presence: "I will be with you." When Moses asks for God's name, the answer is not a title but a declaration of being itself - "I AM WHO I AM." Not I was, not I will be someday, but I AM, right now, in whatever wilderness you're standing in. And in Matthew, Jesus reframes the journey entirely. Following God isn't a path around difficulty - it's a path through it. "Whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me will find it." The journey costs something. But the One who calls us to it walks every step ahead of us and beside us. That's the God we serve, the great I AM who meets us in the wilderness, remembers His promises, and walks with us all the way to the cross and beyond it.

PREPARING YOUR HEART



Silence & Stillness:

Sit quietly, slow your breathing, and invite the Holy Spirit.



Pray Scripture:

Choose a passage (e.g., John 15 or Isaiah 40) and turn each verse into a prayer.

STRUCTURED WAYS



ACTS Model:

Through Adoration, Confession, Thanksgiving, Supplication.



The Lord's Prayer:

Slowly pray each line, pausing to reflect on its meaning and applying it to your life and community.

PRAYING FOR THE WORLD



Prayer Map:

Use a world map. Pray for a nation you've never prayed for before.



News Headlines:

Bring before God a current issue in the world—conflict, disaster, leadership.

PRAYING FOR OTHERS



Family & Friends List:

Write names of people God brings to mind and lift them one by one.



Community Intercession:

Pray for schools, hospitals, businesses, government leaders in our nation.

CREATIVE EXPRESSIONS



Prayer Journaling:

Write a love letter to God or journal what you sense Him saying.



Art & Colour:

Draw or colour while praying for specific people or nations.

MOVEMENTS & PRACTICES



Prayer Walk:

Walk around your house, neighbourhood, or workplace, blessing each space.



Breath Prayer:

As you breathe in say, "Lord Jesus Christ"; as you breathe out, "have mercy on me."

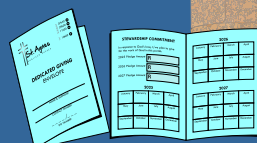
